GoSchoolBox Terms of Service Last Updated: [9/30/21]

Please read these **Terms** of Service (the "Terms") and our Privacy (www.goschoolbox.com/privacy/) ("Privacy Policy") carefully because they govern your use of the website located at www.goschoolbox.com (and all subdomains thereof) (collectively, the "Site") and the technology platform which allows users to operate and use tutoring programs and related services, known as "GoSchoolBox," accessible via the Site offered by Tutorfly, Inc. ("Tutorfly"). If you have a separate platform license agreement with us ("Separate Agreement"), that Separate Agreement takes precedence over these Terms to the extent of any conflicts or inconsistencies herein, however these Terms govern your use of the Services as an end user. To make these Terms easier to read, the Site and our services are collectively called the "Services."

IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING ARBITRATION FOR U.S. CUSTOMERS: WHEN YOU AGREE TO THESE TERMS YOU ARE AGREEING (WITH LIMITED EXCEPTION) TO RESOLVE ANY DISPUTE BETWEEN YOU AND TUTORFLY THROUGH BINDING, INDIVIDUAL ARBITRATION RATHER THAN IN COURT, PROVIDED YOU HAVE NOT EXECUTED A SEPRATE AGREEMENT WITH US. PLEASE REVIEW CAREFULLY SECTION 17 "DISPUTE RESOLUTION" BELOW FOR DETAILS REGARDING ARBITRATION.

- 1. Agreement to Terms. By using our Services, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you don't agree to be bound by these Terms, do not use the Services. If you are accessing and using the Services on behalf of a company (such as your employer) or other legal entity, you represent and warrant that you have the authority to bind that entity to these Terms. In that case, "you" and "your" will refer to that entity. If you are accessing and using the Services as a parent or guardian of or on behalf of a user who is under 13 years of age (or such other minimum age for data collection in their jurisdiction) (a "Child" or "Children"), you represent and warrant that you are the legal parent or guardian of that child, and that you are legally (under the laws of your territory) able to make decisions and provide consents for and on behalf of such Child or Children.

4. Who May Use the Services?

(a) Age Requirements. You may need to provide additional information to verify your identity before completing your Transaction (such information is included within the definition of Payment Information). By initiating a Transaction, you agree to the pricing, payment and billing policies applicable to such fees and charges, as posted or otherwise communicated to you. All payments for Transactions are nonrefundable and non-transferable except as expressly provided in these Terms. All fees and applicable taxes, if any, are payable in United States dollars.
- 7. Audio and Video Content. Our Services offer online educational learning sessions with teachers and tutors (a "Tutoring Session") between users who attend such Tutoring Sessions for educational learning and knowledge purposes (a "Tutees") and users who are teaching and tutoring such Tutees (a "Tutor"). In connection with Tutoring Sessions, our Services offer videoconferencing and audioconferencing functionality. We record audio and video content in connection with Tutoring

Sessions, in accordance with our Privacy Policy. Please see our Privacy Policy for more information regarding our recording, collection, and use of such audio and video content.

8. Your Content.

- (a) Posting Content. Our Services may allow you to store or share content such as text (in posts or communications with others), files, documents, graphics, images, music, software, audio and video (including in connection with videoconferencing or audioconferencing capabilities within any Tutoring Session). Anything (other than Feedback) that you post, display, transmit, or otherwise make available through the Services is referred to as "User Content". Tutorfly does not claim any ownership rights in any User Content and nothing in these Terms will be deemed to restrict any rights that you may have to your User Content.
- (b) Permissions to Your User Content. By making any User Content available through the Services you hereby grant to Tutorfly a non-exclusive, transferable, worldwide, royalty-free license, with the right to sublicense, to use, copy, modify, create derivative works based upon, distribute, publicly display, and publicly perform your User Content in connection with operating and providing the Services, and for Tutorfly's testing, development, maintenance and improvement of the Services and its other products and services generally.
- (c) Your Responsibility for User Content. You are solely responsible for all your User Content. You represent and warrant that (i) you have (and will have) all rights that are necessary to grant us the license rights in your User Content under these Terms, (ii) neither your User Content, nor your use and provision of your User Content to be made available through the Services, nor any use of your User Content by Tutorfly on or through the Services will infringe, misappropriate or violate a third party's intellectual property rights, or rights of publicity or privacy, or result in the violation of any applicable law or regulation, and (iii) you will obtain and maintain at all times all required consents, approvals, permissions, and authorizations under applicable laws (including applicable laws related to data privacy, data security, confidentiality, consumer protection, advertising, electronic mail, and other similar laws, rules, and regulations relating to the privacy and security of personal information or nonpublic information) to provide such User Content through the Services and to grant all rights and licenses to your User Content as set forth in these Terms.
- (d) Removal of User Content. You can remove some of your User Content by specifically deleting it. You should know that in certain instances, some of your User Content (such as posts or comments you make) may not be completely removed and copies of your User Content may continue to exist on the Services. Tutorfly is not obligated to monitor access to or use of the Services or to review or edit any content. However, we have the right to do so for the purpose of operating the Services, to ensure compliance with these Terms and to comply with applicable law or other legal requirements. We reserve the right, but are not obligated, to remove or disable access to any content, including User Content, at any time and without notice, including, but not limited to, if we, at our sole discretion, consider it objectionable or in violation of these Terms. We have the right to investigate violations of these Terms or conduct that affects the Services. We may also consult and cooperate with law enforcement authorities to prosecute users who violate the law.

We make no warranty that the Services will meet your requirements or be available on an uninterrupted, secure, or error-free basis. We make no warranty regarding the quality, accuracy, timeliness, truthfulness, completeness or reliability of any information or content on the Services.
- 14. Indemnity. - (a) TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, NEITHER TUTORFLY NOR ITS SERVICE PROVIDERS INVOLVED IN CREATING, PRODUCING, OR DELIVERING THE SERVICES WILL BE LIABLE FOR ANY INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, EXEMPLARY OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, OR DAMAGES FOR LOST PROFITS, LOST REVENUES, LOST SAVINGS, LOST BUSINESS OPPORTUNITY, LOSS OF DATA OR GOODWILL, SERVICE INTERRUPTION, COMPUTER DAMAGE OR SYSTEM FAILURE OR THE COST OF SUBSTITUTE SERVICES OF ANY KIND ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THESE TERMS OR FROM THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE SERVICES, WHETHER BASED ON WARRANTY, CONTRACT, TORT (INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE), PRODUCT LIABILITY OR ANY OTHER LEGAL THEORY, AND WHETHER OR NOT TUTORFLY OR ITS SERVICE PROVIDERS HAVE BEEN INFORMED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGE, EVEN IF A LIMITED REMEDY SET FORTH HEREIN IS FOUND TO HAVE FAILED OF ITS ESSENTIAL PURPOSE.
- (b) TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY THE LAW OF THE APPLICABLE JURISDICTION, IN NO EVENT WILL TUTORFLY'S TOTAL LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THESE TERMS OR FROM THE USE OF OR INABILITY TO USE THE SERVICES EXCEED THE AMOUNTS YOU HAVE PAID OR ARE PAYABLE BY YOU TO TUTORFLY FOR USE OF THE SERVICES OR ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100), IF YOU HAVE NOT HAD ANY PAYMENT OBLIGATIONS TO TUTORFLY, AS APPLICABLE.
- (c) THE EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF DAMAGES SET FORTH ABOVE ARE FUNDAMENTAL ELEMENTS OF THE BASIS OF THE BARGAIN BETWEEN TUTORFLY AND YOU.

16. Governing Law and Forum Choice. These Terms and any action related thereto will be governed by the Federal Arbitration Act, federal arbitration law, and the laws of the State of California, without regard to its conflict of laws provisions. Except as otherwise expressly set forth in Section 17 "Dispute Resolution," the exclusive jurisdiction for all Disputes (defined below) that you and Tutorfly are not required to arbitrate will be the state and federal courts located in the County of Los Angeles and you and Tutorfly each waive any objection to jurisdiction and venue in such courts.

17. Dispute Resolution.

- (a) Mandatory Arbitration of Disputes. We each agree that any dispute, claim or controversy arising out of or relating to these Terms or the breach, termination, enforcement, interpretation or validity thereof or the use of the Services (collectively, "Disputes") will be resolved solely by binding, individual arbitration and not in a class, representative or consolidated action or proceeding. You and Tutorfly agree that the U.S. Federal Arbitration Act governs the interpretation and enforcement of these Terms, and that you and Tutorfly are each waiving the right to a trial by jury or to participate in a class action. This arbitration provision shall survive termination of these Terms.
- (b) Exceptions. As limited exceptions to Section 17(a) above: (i) we both may seek to resolve a Dispute in small claims court if it qualifies; and (ii) we each retain the right to seek injunctive or other equitable relief from a court to prevent (or enjoin) the infringement or misappropriation of our intellectual property rights.
- (c) <u>Conducting Arbitration and Arbitration Rules</u>. The arbitration will be conducted by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") under its Consumer Arbitration Rules (the "AAA Rules") then in effect, except as modified by these Terms. The AAA Rules are available at www.adr.org or by calling 1-800-778-7879. A party who wishes to start arbitration must submit a written Demand for Arbitration to AAA and give notice to the other party as specified in the AAA Rules. The AAA provides a form Demand for Arbitration at www.adr.org.

Any arbitration hearings will take place in the county (or parish) where you live, unless we both agree to a different location. The parties agree that the arbitrator shall have exclusive authority to decide all issues relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability and scope of this arbitration agreement.

- (d) <u>Arbitration Costs</u>. Payment of all filing, administration and arbitrator fees will be governed by the AAA Rules, and we won't seek to recover the administration and arbitrator fees we are responsible for paying, unless the arbitrator finds your Dispute frivolous. If we prevail in arbitration we'll pay all of our attorneys' fees and costs and won't seek to recover them from you. If you prevail in arbitration you will be entitled to an award of attorneys' fees and expenses to the extent provided under applicable law.
- (e) <u>Injunctive and Declaratory Relief</u>. Except as provided in Section 17(b) above, the arbitrator shall determine all issues of liability on the merits of any claim asserted by either party and may award declaratory or injunctive relief only in favor of the individual party seeking relief and only to the extent necessary to provide relief warranted by that party's individual claim. To the extent that you or we prevail on a claim and seek public injunctive relief (that is, injunctive relief that has the primary purpose and effect of prohibiting unlawful acts that threaten future injury to the public), the entitlement to and extent of such relief must be litigated in a civil court

of competent jurisdiction and not in arbitration. The parties agree that litigation of any issues of public injunctive relief shall be stayed pending the outcome of the merits of any individual claims in arbitration.

- CLAIMS AGAINST THE OTHER ONLY IN YOUR OR ITS INDIVIDUAL CAPACITY, AND NOT AS A PLAINTIFF OR CLASS MEMBER IN ANY PURPORTED CLASS OR REPRESENTATIVE PROCEEDING. Further, if the parties' Dispute is resolved through arbitration, the arbitrator may not consolidate another person's claims with your claims, and may not otherwise preside over any form of a representative or class proceeding. If this specific provision is found to be unenforceable, then the entirety of this Dispute Resolution section shall be null and void.
- (g) Severability. With the exception of any of the provisions in Section 17(f) of these Terms ("Class Action Waiver"), if an arbitrator or court of competent jurisdiction decides that any part of these Terms is invalid or unenforceable, the other parts of these Terms will still apply.

18. General Terms.

- (a) Reservation of Rights. Tutorfly and its licensors exclusively own all right, title and interest in and to the Services, including all associated intellectual property rights. You acknowledge that the Services are protected by copyright, trademark, and other laws of the United States and foreign countries. You agree not to remove, alter or obscure any copyright, trademark, service mark or other proprietary rights notices incorporated in or accompanying the Services.
- (b) Entire Agreement. These Terms constitute the entire and exclusive understanding and agreement between Tutorfly and you regarding the Services, and these Terms supersede and replace all prior oral or written understandings or agreements between Tutorfly and you regarding the Services. If any provision of these Terms is held invalid or unenforceable by an arbitrator or a court of competent jurisdiction, that provision will be enforced to the maximum extent permissible and the other provisions of these Terms will remain in full force and effect. You may not assign or transfer these Terms, by operation of law or otherwise, without Tutorfly's prior written consent. Any attempt by you to assign or transfer these Terms, without such consent, will be null. Tutorfly may freely assign or transfer these Terms without restriction. Subject to the foregoing, these Terms will bind and inure to the benefit of the parties, their successors and permitted assigns.
- (c) <u>Notices</u>. Any notices or other communications provided by Tutorfly under these Terms will be given: (i) via email; or (ii) by posting to the Services. For notices made by email, the date of receipt will be deemed the date on which such notice is transmitted.
- (d) <u>Waiver of Rights</u>. Tutorfly's failure to enforce any right or provision of these Terms will not be considered a waiver of such right or provision. The waiver of any such right or provision will be effective only if in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of Tutorfly. Except as expressly set forth in these Terms, the exercise by either party of any of its remedies under these Terms will be without prejudice to its other remedies under these Terms or otherwise.
